Canoeing at TUCC

Summer Season (1st April - 30th September) - Level 2 training and proficiency will be held during these dates. Improver courses will be provided at local sites during these dates. Beginner and improver courses will not be offered outside of the summer season.

Winter Season (1st October - 31st March) - Courses and trips will be held for paddlers who have sufficient level 2 experience during these times. Trips will be offered on the basis of experience and water levels, at the discretion of the group leader.

Please Note: - Tullamore Canoe Club at all times aims to provide enjoyable and safe paddling for all of its members. However, all events are dependent on conditions at the time, and may be cancelled or postponed at the discretion of the club. The club has the right to refuse entry to the water any member who, in the opinion of the group leader, is not suitable attired for the trip, or may compromise the safety of themselves and/or the rest of the group.

Paddlers who have not paid membership do not have permission to utilise facilities in or around the Tullamore Canoe Club Clubhouse. The only exceptions for this are, The Parent/Legal Guardian of a member, Individuals who are taking part in a TUCC run course and Individuals who are invited to the clubhouse by the Steering Committee of the Club.

- 3 I authorise Tullamore Canoe Club, in the event that I cannot be contacted or if any urgency dictates, to act in the best interests for the Child(ren) in respect of any circumstances, including accident or illness, which may necessitate medical treatment, including surgery, and on my behalf to authorise any such treatment or surgery which they, in their sole discretion, (which discretion shall not be unreasonably exercised), may deem necessary provided any such medical treatment is performed by a duly licenced practitioner.

- 4 I authorise Tullamore Canoe Club to publish canoeing related images including photographs and film of my child(ren) on the club website, the club facebook page, in club publications and in local or national print or electronic media in accordance to GDPR guidelines, policies and procedures.

- 5 I acknowledge that Tullamore Canoe Club is in no way responsible for canoeing/kayaking activities which my Child(ren) may participate in outside of official club events, regardless of my Child(s) use of club equipment at the said event.

- 6 PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE EXPECTED TO:
 - a) Inform the event leader at the start of every event of any health issues pertaining to their child. In Particular, make the leader aware of any medications, (inhalers etc.) Which the child needs to carry during the event.
 - b) Deliver and collect their child to and from the event. The Club, its leaders, helpers or other adult members are not responsible for the child before getting on the water or after getting off the water. It is recommended that parents/guardians of children under the age of 14 remain on site during activities
 - c) Ensure that their child is properly clothed for the activity, taking into account weather conditions.
 - d) Ensure that their child has adequate nutrition for the duration of the activity.
 - e) Accompany their child on any overnight activities or trips.
 - f) Abide by the recommendations of the Tullamore Canoe Club Code of Conduct.
